Fatal Traffic Collision - UPDATE

La Habra, CA – December 11, 2017: This is an update to the below Press Release that was issued on December 10, 2017 as was detailed below. The deceased pedestrian has been identified as DAVID LEE (76 years old) from La Habra. Mr. Lee’s next of kin has been notified.

Preliminary investigation has indicated the pedestrian was attempting to cross Lambert about 200 feet west of the nearest marked crosswalk at the signalized intersection with Euclid. The pedestrian was struck by a sedan that was westbound on Lambert. The investigation is still on-going and anyone who may have witnessed the collision, or the events leading up to it, are asked to contact the LHPD Traffic Bureau at 562-383-4300.

La Habra, CA – December 10, 2017: At approximately 5:10 p.m., officers were dispatched to the intersection of Euclid Street and Lambert Road, in the City of La Habra, regarding an injury traffic collision. When officers arrived, they discovered that an elderly male had been struck head-on by a vehicle. Officers performed lifesaving measures until the elderly male was transported to the hospital by Los Angeles County Fire Department. The elderly male later succumbed to his injuries while he was treated at the hospital. At this time, the male victim

is not being identified. The Orange County Corners Office will be handling family notification.

The driver of the vehicle was uninjured and there were no signs of intoxication. This investigation is still on going.
