Early Childhood/Museum Education Internship

The Children's Museum at La Habra is currently recruiting an intern who is interested in playing a direct role in inspiring today's youth to learn in a hands-on environment. All applicants should be organized, self-motivated, and have excellent people skills. All internship positions are on a voluntary basis only. Interns will assist with general operation duties as well as duties within a specific area of interest.

This internship is meant to be adaptable to intern's interests and/or experience. Under the supervision of education staff, the intern may decide to support already established programs such as Lil' Innovators workshops (a grant-funded program offering STEM education to underserved children, their parents, and their teachers) and lead tours for pre-k to 2nd grade students OR, create curriculum for Little Learners mini-classes at the museum. Interns may also assist with special events.

Requirements:

- Current college student or recent graduate
- Some coursework in early childhood development, science education, and/or experience with museum education
- LiveScan fingerprinting and drug test (through city of La Habra)
- Experience with preschool curriculums, Common Core standards, or Next Generation Science standards preferred
- Bilingual (Spanish, Chinese, Korean) applicants encouraged to apply
