## LA HABRA'S Military Recognition Banner Program



*The City of La Habra invites you to participate in the La Habra Military Recognition Banner Program, which offers an opportunity to honor past and present military personnel who reside in the city.*

**Who qualifies for a banner?** Anyone who lives or lived in La Habra during their military service.

**What do the banners look like?** Banners are made from a 15 oz. double-sided "blackout" material and measure 30" by 90" with 2" top and bottom pockets.

**Where will the banners be displayed?** They will be installed by the City along La Habra Blvd.

**How long will the banner be displayed?** Banners will be displayed for two years to ensure quality, and then given to the family as a keepsake after being removed.

**What is the cost of the banner?** The cost is \$224 per banner, which includes banner, installation & care.

**How can I order a banner?** Contact LHMilitaryBanners@lahabracity.gov or 562-383-4200.



## A Century of Community: Celebrating 100 Years of La Habra

*2025 was a year to celebrate! One hundred years ago, on Jan. 20, 1925, the City of La Habra was officially incorporated, marking the beginning of a remarkable journey that continues to inspire generations today. Over the past century, La Habra has evolved from a small rural town into a vibrant, thriving city — all while maintaining the cultural warmth, community spirit, and neighborly heart that define it.*

### A YEAR-LONG CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION

To honor this monumental milestone, the La Habra Centennial Committee set out to create a year filled with reflection, recognition, and community pride. From January to December 2025, La Habra came alive with commemorative programs, historic displays, and unforgettable moments that united generations of La Habrans.

### A YEAR OF HIGHLIGHTS

- The Centennial festivities began with a City Hall Kick-Off Celebration. The event featured the unveiling of a new Centennial mural, historic photo displays, live music, and the first of many keepsakes released during the year.
- The Committee championed the renaming of the city's newest park to Vin Scully Centennial Park, honoring the beloved broadcaster's legacy of integrity, family, and support to the La Habra community.
- Beloved annual events received Centennial enhancements including the La Habra 5K, Concerts and Movies in the Park, the Fourth of July Celebration, and the La Habra Tamale Festival.

- Centenarians were honored at a Council Meeting. The committee was honored to recognize a truly extraordinary group of individuals, houses/buildings, organizations, school districts, and churches. These remarkable Centenarians have witnessed firsthand the growth, change, and evolution of our city over the last century.

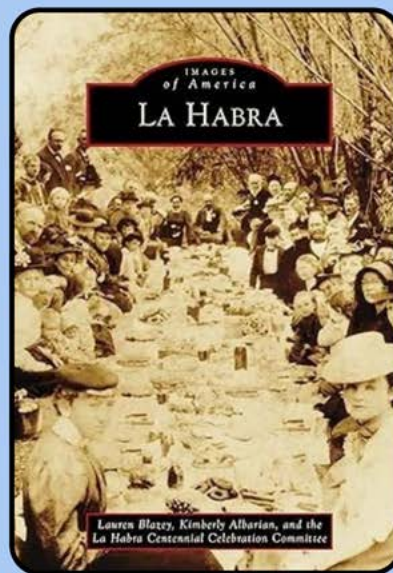

# Vin Scully Centennial Park Ribbon Cutting

The City of La Habra proudly celebrated the grand opening of Vin Scully Centennial Park on Saturday, Nov. 8, with a ribbon-cutting ceremony featuring remarks from Mayor Espinoza, City Councilmembers, Assembly member Blanca Pacheco, former Dodger Jimmy Campanis, and current La Habra resident and former Minnesota Twins player, Darrell Jackson.

The Dodger's Hall of Fame broadcaster Vin Scully was the guest of honor when the baseball diamond was officially named "Vin Scully Field" in 1960. Now, 65 years later, the City Council voted to recognize Vin Scully by including his name in the official naming of the new park, Vin Scully Centennial Park, in celebration of the City's 100th birthday.

The park project was funded through different community partners including California State Parks Department, Proposition 68, a bond measure that allocated resources for statewide initiatives related to water, parks and climate resilience and through your local tax dollars. The City also received grants from Providence St. Jude Medical Center for the fitness equipment and Move More Eat Healthy signage and Cal Recycle to help ensure a clean park.



Now open daily from dawn to dusk, the 17.7-acre park offers many new amenities for residents and visitors, including a playground, theater for entertainment, plenty of green space, gazebo, picnic benches, BBQs, a big and small dog park, volleyball, pickleball, and basketball courts, a walking path, and accessible fitness equipment for all levels.

Vin Scully Centennial Park encourages connection through play for a healthy and active La Habra community. We look forward to all the memories that will be created at this new community gathering space.

# City Opens New Self-Serve Compost Station

In July 2025, the City of La Habra opened up a new self-serve compost station at Loma Norte Park. The compost is from the County of Orange Brea Greenery and is STA certified meaning it has the Seal of Testing Assurance from the U.S. Compost Council. The County conducts regular testing to ensure quality. This is the same compost that the City has handed out during past City events in bags. The compost at this station is loose and not in bags.



As a self-service station, residents must bring their own shovels and containers (bags, buckets, bins, etc.). The compost is first-come, first-served, and will be frequently restocked with fresh compost. There is no limit to how much compost one may take. The compost is free to all La Habra residents, businesses, and landscapers. Even non-residents and businesses from neighboring cities from Brea and La Habra Heights and Whittier are welcome to take from La Habra's compost station.

The compost station is located near the Ladera Palma baseball field back parking lot up at the top of the driveway at 2051 Brookdale Ave.

### COMPOST STATION GUIDELINES:

- Compost is first come, first served.
- Compost is free to use for anyone who needs it, including contractors.
- Shovels and bags are not provided. Please bring shovels and containers.

- Vehicles must not block the driveway. If no parking spaces are available, please return later.
- Vehicle queuing down the driveway or onto Brookdale Ave. is not allowed.
- Fill buckets 1/2 to 2/3 full. The amount of moisture in the compost will make the load heavier.
- Use proper lifting techniques when loading.
- Do not overload vehicles. An overloaded vehicle can result in diminished handling and braking. Use extra care when driving.
- Take care when loading and transporting the compost. Try to not make a mess.

scaffolding of the Sistine Chapel and lie on their backs to sketch Michelangelo's ceiling masterpieces.

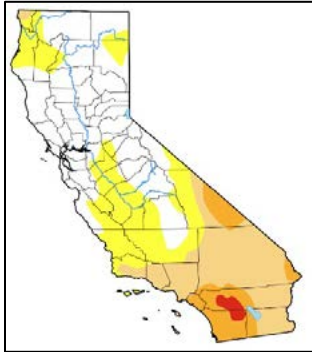

# La Habra Water Restrictions Update



As of Nov. 5, 2024, the U.S. Drought Monitor rates La Habra as being in moderate drought, which is a level 2 out of 5 levels. For the State of California, 42% of the state is at a level 0 and 58% of the state has drought levels from level 1 (dry) to 4 (extreme).

In the western region, which includes Arizona, California, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming, 74% of this area (up from 43% a year ago) is under some level of drought and 33.8% is severe or worse (up from 18% a year ago). The National Weather Service's Climate Prediction Center currently shows that in the next three months, the drought conditions will continue to persist in the greater Los Angeles area including Orange County.

The current drought situation could change depending on this winter's rainfall amounts. Current forecasts show a 50/50 chance of normal rainfall amounts. Residents must continue to follow the mindset that water conservation is a way of life in La Habra. The City is and will remain at a Water Shortage Contingency Plan Level 2.

As a result, during our winter schedule, irrigation is limited to no more than three (3) days per week from November to March, but due to grass going dormant in the winter, the City recommends only watering one day per week (1).

Odd-numbered addresses may only irrigate on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. Even-numbered addresses may only irrigate on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.

The three day per week restriction does not apply to landscape irrigation zones that exclusively use very low flow drip type irrigation systems when no emitter produces more than two gallons of water per hour. This provision also does not apply to watering or irrigating by use of a hand-held bucket or similar container, a hand-held hose equipped with a positive self-closing water shut-off nozzle or device, or for very short periods for the express purpose of adjusting or repairing an irrigation system.

### PERMANENT RESTRICTIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- Watering lawns is prohibited between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- Water runoff is prohibited.
- Washing down hard surfaces (sidewalks, driveways, parking areas, walkways, etc.) is prohibited.
- Repair leaks or malfunctions must be repaired in a timely manner (within four days of notification under Level 2 demand reduction actions).
- Washing any vehicle with water is prohibited except by use of handheld bucket or an automatic shut off nozzle or the vehicle is taken to a commercial car washing facility that uses a recirculating system.
- Water no more than 15 minutes per station (valve) per day.
- No landscape watering within 48 hours after measurable precipitation.
- The Department of Water Resources has prohibited the use of potable water for the irrigation of non-functional turf at commercial, industrial, and institutional sites, and includes homeowners' associations.

### REBATE OPPORTUNITIES INCLUDE:

- Turf Removal: Rebates start at \$3 per square foot (Artificial or synthetic turf is not eligible for a rebate)
- Drip Irrigation: Rebates start at \$1 per square foot
- Smart Sprinkler Timers: \$180 for properties less than one acre, \$50 per station for properties greater than one acre
- Soil Sensors: Rebates start at \$180 per device OR \$35 per station for sites over 1 acre
- Rotating Sprinkler Nozzles: \$2 per nozzle, 15 nozzle minimum
- Rain Barrels: \$35 per barrel, \$250 per cistern
- High Efficiency Clothes Washers: \$85 per washer
- High Efficiency Toilets: \$40 per toilet
- Flow Monitor Devices: \$100
- Landscape Designs: Free

# La Habra's Bulky Item Program

*Are you familiar with the City's Bulky Item Collection Program? In the City of La Habra, single-family households, multi-family households, and businesses are eligible.*

## SINGLE-FAMILY HOUSEHOLDS

Single-family households with curbside cart service are entitled to four (4) free bulky item pickups per calendar year. Residents may dispose either of the following per pickup:

- 4 large household items; or
- 20 plastic bags of trash or greenwaste

## MULTI-FAMILY HOUSEHOLDS

Multi-family households with bin service are entitled to four (4) free bulky item pickups per dwelling unit per calendar year. Each pickup is limited to the greater of:

- 4 large household items;
- 20 plastic bags of trash or greenwaste; or
- 3 cubic yards by volume per collection event (i.e., per pickup)

## BUSINESSES

Businesses are limited to two (2) large items per collection event (i.e., per pickup). For collections of bulky items from commercial cart and commercial bin customers, the charge for each pickup is \$40.99.

Bulky items include large, hard to handle items that require more than one person to move them. Examples of bulky items include:

- Couches, desks, chairs, tables, mattresses
- Household appliances: refrigerators, water heaters, washers, dryers
- Excess green waste (bagged)
- Electronic waste: televisions, microwaves, computers, printers, monitors
- Universal waste: household batteries, fluorescent tubes

### Do:

- Do call CR&R customer service to make an appointment.
- Do leave out items on collection day only.
- Do keep items close to the curb in a safe and organized manner.

### Do Not:

- Don't illegally dump/leave items on a property that is not your own. This is punishable by fine of up to \$1,000 per incident.
- Don't leave items on your curb without making an appointment (this is also considered illegal dumping).
- Don't leave out hazardous waste items.

# Holiday Schedule & Reminders...

## CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

The City's waste hauler, CR&R Incorporated, will collect and recycle Christmas trees for the first three weeks following Christmas on your regular collection day through Jan. 16, 2026. Trees taller than six feet must be cut in half. Please remove all decorations including tinsel, lights, ornaments, and tree stands. Place the tree at the curb. Flocked trees will be collected, but cannot be recycled. Trees being disposed of after the three-week period must be cut into small pieces and recycled as regular green waste during the regular pick up.

## TRASH COLLECTION

As you may know, trash collection does not occur on the Christmas Day and New Year's Day holidays in La Habra and service is usually delayed during the rest of the week following the holiday. This year, Christmas Day will fall on a Thursday. As a result, regular day trash service will be delayed by one day, each day, starting from that Thursday through the rest of the week. If your regular pickup day is Thursday, your trash will be picked up on Friday. Regular Friday customers that week will be picked up on Saturday, Dec. 27, 2025. The trash pickup schedule for the week of Jan. 1, 2026 (New Year's Day is also on a Thursday) will also follow the same format and all trash services will be delayed for one day for the rest of that week.

## STREET SWEEPING SCHEDULE

Since Christmas and New Year's Day both fall on Thursday's this year, street sweeping services will be delayed by one day, each day, starting from each Thursday through the rest of the week. If your regular sweeping day is

Thursday, your street will be swept on Friday and so on. Regular Friday sweeping will not occur on Friday or Saturday and will not be made up until the regular schedule returns the week of Jan. 5, 2026.

Parking enforcement for street sweeping will not occur between Dec. 24, 2025 and Jan. 4, 2026. The street sweeping ticketing program will get back to a normal schedule starting on Monday, Jan. 5, 2026.

## OVERNIGHT PARKING

The City of La Habra will suspend enforcement of the overnight parking ordinance during the holiday season. Enforcement of the parking ordinance will not occur from Friday, Nov. 21, 2025 at 12 a.m. through Thursday, Jan. 1, 2026. Enforcement will resume Friday, Jan. 2, 2026 at 12 a.m. For overnight parking or other ticketing questions, please contact the La Habra Police Department at **562-383-4300**.

LA HABRA'S DROUGHT TOLERANT PLANTS:

## *Black Sage* (*Salvia mellifera*)



Native to California and Baja California, Mexico, Black Sage is the most common sage found in California. The plant is mostly found in plains and hills below 2,000 feet. The flowers can be pale blue, lavender, or pale rose and have a pleasant scent. The flowers bloom in springtime and summer. The flowers are an important food source for bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds. The seeds provide food for quail and other birds.

Black Sage grows best in full sun or part shade. For planting, use well-draining soil. For summer watering, the plant can be naturalized, but can also tolerate watering up to one time per month when established. At maturity, the plant has a 3-to-5-foot height and a 6-foot spread at the base. It is hardy down to 15 degrees Fahrenheit before stem damage occurs. Black sage is good for bank stabilization, for a ground cover, or as a hedge. Pruning helps to keep it

neat and compact. Native Chumash people would use Black Sage to make a sun tea which then was then used as a pain reliever when applied to a painful area such as soaking one's feet for example. The honey that is made from Black Sage has been known to be rare with unique flavor that is strong and peppery.

## LA HABRA SENIOR TRANSPORTATION PROGRAMS

*The La Habra Community Services Department offers two curb-to-curb transportation services for seniors.*

### LA HABRA "RIDE WITH PRIDE" SHUTTLE SERVICE

This service is open to *seniors age 60+ years*, operates Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 2 p.m., and transports riders from their homes to and from the Community Center for the lunch program and other Community Center activities and events. To make reservations to use the "Ride with Pride" Shuttle Service, please call the shuttle reservation line: **424-398-5990**.

### LA HABRA CAR SERVICE

This service is open to *seniors age 60+ years*, operates Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and transports riders for doctor's appointments within a radius of 10 miles of La Habra and grocery shopping in La Habra. The only destinations outside of Orange County are Presbyterian Intercommunity Hospital (PIH) in Whittier and the Veterans Administration Hospital in Long Beach. Rides are limited to either two one-way trips OR one round-trip per week. Reservations must be made at least three business days in advance.

To make reservations to use the La Habra Car Service, please call the Car Service reservation line: **877-762-6061**.

Riders who meet the age qualifications are eligible to use either or both services. To use either of the transportation services, you must register by completing an application form and return it to the La Habra Community Services Department, 101 W. La Habra Blvd., as well as providing photo identification with proof of residence and birthdate.

Applications are available at the Community Center, where they can be completed and turned in, or they can be mailed out and returned via USPS mail with a copy of the identification document, or can be downloaded from the City's website, [lahabraca.gov](http://lahabraca.gov), completed, scanned and emailed, along with the identification document, to [hharkins@lahabraca.gov](mailto:hharkins@lahabraca.gov). Identification documents are destroyed after we review them.
